**SPORTS PREMIUM SPENDING 2018/19**



Sports Premium is additional funding for publicly funded schools in England to improve the provision of Sports and PE within school.

**Aims of Sports Premium Spending:**

- Improving the quality of teaching and learning in P.E and Sports.
- Increasing participation in sporting activities outside of the core curriculum, during lunchtimes and after school.
- Improving pupils' lifestyles and physical wellbeing.

**There are 5 key indicators we aim to see improvement across in sport, as identified by the Sport Premium Guidance. These are:**

- the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity - the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 5 to 18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school
- the profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement
- increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- increased participation in competitive sport

**We aim to achieve this by ensuring:**

- All pupils benefit regardless of sporting ability
- Staff have access to training opportunities and continued professional development
- Continued membership of the Leisureworks sport SLA
- Continuing to take part in local sports competitions/events organised during the year 2017 - 2018
- Making links to other community sports providers – encouraging pupils to join out of school sports clubs
- Children across all key stages enjoy PE and are enthusiastic about learning new sports and gaining new skills.
- After School Sports clubs to grow, whilst remaining an integral part of school life.
- A greater number of children regularly use lunchtimes to enjoy sporting activities, demonstrating a good understanding of sporting values, particularly less active children
- The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – kick-starting healthy active lifestyles

<b>Issue</b>	<b>Increase children's opportunities to be active for sustained periods.</b>
<b>Aims:</b>	Provide opportunities for children to active for at least 30 minutes per day every day. Increase breadth of opportunities, including beyond Curriculum entitlement. Recognise Sports provision through achievement of Sainsbury's School Games Award- at least Silver Standard Increase use of IT for tracking , assessment and monitoring
