7:30 - 8:30	Breakfast
8:30 - 9:00	Quiet reading time / colouring / jigsaws / 1:1 check ins with staff (SMSC)
9:00 - 10:00	Active Time e.g. a nature walk, bird watching, forest school activities, treasure hunt, scavenger hunt, sports races, free play, access to play equipment, singing and dancing, music activities.
10:00 - 10:30	Snack and chat
10:30 - 11:30	Creative Crafts e.g. collages, painting, sand and water play, sewing, DT project, junk modelling, cooking / baking / food tech.
11:30 – 12:00	Number games e.g. online number work Cbeebies, times tables rock stars, numbots, hopscotch, card games, matching and counting activities
12:00 - 12:45	Lunchtime and play
12:45 - 1:15	Free play Indoor free play Lego, blocks, puppet shows, drama, role play, ICT, playdough, marbles
1:15 - 2:15	STEM activities e.g. science projects, maths problem solving activities, build something, ICT coding
2:15 - 2:45	Go for a walk / gardening
2:45 - 3:45	Project work / DVD session Learn about a country over a period of time, learn about a period in history, learn something another language, video blogs, make a time capsule, prepare a performance to video and upload.
3:45 - 4:15	Games and puzzles e.g. board games, playing cards, charades, simon says, team quizzes, word searches
4:15 - 4:45	Relax kids or another meditation programme.
4:45 - 5:15	Story time
